**Annex to Resolution 79 of the Scientific Board
of IHN PAN of 30 November 2023.**

**Regulations for the award of the habilitation degree
at the Ludwik and Aleksander Birkenmajer Institute for the History of Science of the
Polish Academy of Sciences**

General provisions

§ 1

These Regulations for the conferment of the habilitation degree at the Ludwik and Aleksander Birkenmajer Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences, hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations", specify:

- 1) detailed procedure for the conferment of the degree of habilitation,
- 2) the rules for determining the amount of, and exemption from, the fee for proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree,
- 3) the method of appointing members of the habilitation committee,
- 4) model habilitation diploma.

§ 2

Proceedings for the conferment of the degree of "doktor habilitowany" at the Ludwik and Aleksander Birkenmajer Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences shall be conducted in particular on the basis of the following provisions:

- 1) The Act of 20 July 2018. - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws 2022, item 574), hereinafter referred to as the "Act";
- 2) Statutes of the Ludwik and Aleksander Birkenmajer Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences;
- 3) these Rules;

- 4) appropriately applied provisions of the Act of 14 June 1960. - Code of Administrative Procedure (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 2000), hereinafter referred to as the "Code of Administrative Procedure".

Initiation of proceedings for the conferral of the habilitation degree and its conduct

§ 3

1. Proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree shall be initiated at the request, hereinafter referred to as the "Application", submitted by an applicant for the conferment of the habilitation degree, hereinafter referred to as the "habilitation Candidate", through the Board for Scientific Excellence, hereinafter referred to as the "RDN", to the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences, with the exception of the situation referred to in Article 221, paragraph 3 of the Act.
2. The application should be prepared in Polish, in accordance with the recommendations described on the website of the Board for Scientific Excellence (www.rdn.gov.pl) and with these Regulations, and should include the following information:
 - 1) the name and postal address of the habilitation Candidate;
 - 2) indication of the main place of work or places of work (in the case of an academic teacher or researcher);
 - 3) the designation of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences as the habilitation body, with the exception of Applications forwarded by the RDN in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 221(3) of the Act;
 - 4) the field of science and the scientific discipline in which the habilitation Candidate is applying for the award of the degree of Doctor of Science;
 - 5) identification of the scientific achievement which is the basis for the habilitation Candidate's application for the award of the degree of Doctor of Science;
 - 6) to indicate whether the resolution referred to in the first sentence of section 221 (10) of the Act is to be adopted by secret ballot;

- 7) consent to the processing of personal data beyond that which is necessary for the conduct of the procedure for the award of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy, processed by law;
 - 8) signature of the habilitation Candidate.
- 3.** The Application should be accompanied by:
- 1) details of the Applicant, as described on the website of the Board for Scientific Excellence (www.rdn.gov.pl);
 - 2) a copy of the document certifying possession of a doctoral degree,
 - 3) the list of achievements referred to in Article 219(1)(2) of the Act;
 - 4) a self-reference containing, in particular, a description of the habilitation Candidate's professional career, a discussion of the achievements referred to in Article 219, para. 1, pt. 2 of the Act, and information on the demonstration of significant scientific or artistic activity pursued in more than one university, scientific institution or cultural institution, in particular a foreign institution (art. 219 para. 1 item 3 of the Act);
 - 5) a statement affirming that the application has not been the subject of any other proceedings for the award of the habilitation degree.
- 4.** The indication by the habilitation Candidate in the Application of the achievements referred to in Article 219, para. 2 of the Act shall be accompanied by a declaration of the Candidate and the co-authors indicating their substantive contribution to the creation of each work. The identification of the contribution of a particular author, including the habilitation Candidate, should be sufficiently precise to allow an accurate assessment of their contribution and role in the creation of each work. A co-author statement is not required in the event of the death of the co-author or other legitimate circumstances preventing a statement from being obtained.
- 5.** The Chairperson of the Scientific Board of IHN PAN, hereinafter referred to as the "Chairperson of the Board", shall check the compliance of the Application with the requirements of these Regulations. If the Application does not meet the requirements of these Regulations, the Chairperson of the Board shall call upon the habilitation Candidate to supplement it by setting an appropriate deadline, no shorter than 7 days.

6. If the Application is not completed within the prescribed period, the Application shall be left unprocessed.

§ 4

1. Subject to the situation referred to in para. 4, within 4 weeks of the date of receipt of the complete Application at the Institute for the History of Science PAN, the Scientific Board of the Institute for the History of Science PAN, hereinafter referred to as the "Scientific Board", shall put to a vote a resolution to consent to the proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree on the the conferment of the habilitation degree of on the habilitation Candidate.
2. If the resolution referred to in paragraph 1 has not received the required simple majority of votes, the Scientific Board shall put to a vote a resolution not to authorise proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree on the the conferment of the habilitation degree of on the habilitation Candidate.
3. In case a meeting of the Scientific Board is not scheduled within the period indicated in paragraph 1 above, the resolution referred to in paragraph 1 above shall be adopted by individual collection of votes (circulation procedure). A resolution of the Scientific Board shall not require justification.
4. In a situation in which IHN PAN is the habilitation subject designated by the RDN, the Scientific Board shall not adopt the resolution referred to in paragraph 1 (Article 221, paragraph 3 of the Act).

Rules for determining the amount of and exemption from the proceedings fee

§ 5

1. The fee for the conduct of proceedings for the conferment of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy shall be:
 - 1) reviewers' remuneration for preparing reviews and fees for members of the habilitation committee in the amount specified in Article 184, section 3, item 2 and

Article 184, section 4 of the Act, as well as the social and health insurance contributions due in accordance with the applicable legislation;

- 2) the travel and accommodation costs, if any, of the members of the Habilitation Committee in connection with the necessity to attend the activities of the procedure for the conferment of the habilitation degree, if these take place away from their place of residence;
 - 3) the cost of issuing a copy of the habilitation diploma in Polish and foreign languages;
 - 4) reasonable administrative, postal and material costs of 10% of the costs referred to in points 1 to 3 above (administrative fee).
2. In particularly justified cases, at the written request of the habilitation Candidate, the Director of the Institute for the History of Science PAN may exempt the Candidate from the fee referred to in this paragraph in whole or in part. The Director of the Institute for the History of Science PAN may call upon the habilitation Candidate to supplement the application referred to in the previous sentence by indicating additional information or submitting new documents.

Procedure for the appointment of the Habilitation Committee and its tasks

§ 6

1. The Scientific Board shall, within 6 weeks of being informed of the members of the Habilitation Committee appointed by the RDN, appoint a seven (7) member Habilitation Committee consisting of:
 - 1) four members appointed by the RDN, including the Chair of the Habilitation Committee and three reviewers;
 - 2) member and member-secretary, holding a post-doctoral degree or a professorial title, employed at the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences;

- 3) a reviewer member holding a post-doctoral or professorial degree, who is not an employee of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences.
2. Candidates for members of the Habilitation Committee, appointed by the Scientific Board, may be proposed by any member of the Scientific Board entitled to vote.
3. Members of the Habilitation Committee should be persons in respect of whom there are no circumstances that might cast doubt on their impartiality.
4. The Scientific Board shall vote separately on the appointment of each member of the Habilitation Committee. If the member appointed by the RDN is not appointed as a member of the Habilitation Committee, the Chairperson of the Scientific Board shall request the RDN to appoint another member of the Habilitation Committee. At the next meeting of the Scientific Board after receiving information from the RDN on the appointment of another member of the Habilitation Commission, the Scientific Board shall vote on the appointment of the designated person as a member of the Habilitation Commission.
5. A single resolution of the Scientific Board on the appointment of the Habilitation Committee shall be drawn up from the votes referred to in paragraph 4 above and shall include all the names of the members of the Habilitation Committee together with the results of the votes for them.
6. The Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences includes:
 - 1) with the members of the Habilitation Committee who are not employees of the Institute for the History of the Polish Academy of Sciences, contractual agreements to act as members of the Habilitation Committee,
 - 2) agreements with reviewer members to carry out reviews and transfer copyright.
7. In particular, the members of the Habilitation Committee shall make the following declarations:
 - 1) that there are no circumstances that might cast doubt on the impartiality of the members of the Habilitation Committee,

- 2) that no disciplinary penalty has been imposed on members of the Habilitation Committee disqualifying them from acting as committee members in proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree, and that furthermore no disciplinary penalty has been imposed on reviewers disqualifying them from acting as reviewers;
- 3) In the case of reviewer members, a declaration that during the past 5 years there have been no two instances of failure to meet the 8-week deadline for preparing a review in the procedure for conferring the degree of “doktor habilitowany.”

§ 7

1. The declaration of resignation as a member of the Habilitation Committee should be submitted in writing or in documentary form with justification to the Chair of the Scientific Board.
2. In the event that the declaration referred to in paragraph 1 is made by a member of the Habilitation Committee appointed by the RDN, the Chairperson of the Scientific Board shall send this declaration to the RDN with a request to accept or refuse it and, in the former situation, at the same time to appoint a new member of the Habilitation Committee. In the case referred to in the previous sentence in fine, the Scientific Board shall adopt a resolution to amend the resolution on the appointment of the Habilitation Committee.
3. In the event that the declaration referred to in paragraph 1 is made by a member-reviewer appointed by the Scientific Board who is an academic teacher or a researcher, the Scientific Board shall put to a vote a resolution to accept the declaration referred to in this sentence. If the resolution referred to in the previous sentence is positive, the Scientific Board shall pass a resolution to amend the resolution on the appointment of the Habilitation Committee.
4. If the declaration referred to in paragraph 1 is made by a member of the Habilitation Committee appointed by the Scientific Board who is not a reviewer, the Scientific Board shall adopt a resolution to amend the resolution on the appointment of the habilitation committee.

§ 8

1. The Chair of the Habilitation Committee in particular:
 - 1) organises the work of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 2) convenes and chairs meetings of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 3) Ensures the smooth conduct of discussions during the meetings of the Habilitation Committee, including the Habilitation Colloquium;
 - 4) orders the votes, specifies precisely their subject matter and the manner in which they are to be held;
 - 5) supervises the regularity of the activities carried out by the Habilitation Committee;
 - 6) participates in votes and discussions at meetings of the Habilitation Committee, including the Habilitation Colloquium.
2. Secretary of the Habilitation Committee in particular:
 - 1) on behalf of the Chair of the Habilitation Committee, performs activities concerning the organisation of the work of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 2) mediates the contact and exchange of information between the members of the Habilitation Committee, as well as between the Habilitation Committee and the staff of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences;
 - 3) ensure the smooth circulation of documents between the members of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 4) provide technical support for the activities of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 5) draw up the minutes of each meeting of the Habilitation Committee;
 - 6) participates in votes, discussions during meetings of the Habilitation Committee, including the Habilitation Colloquium.
3. Reviewer for the Habilitation Committee in particular:
 - 1) draw up an unambiguous, well-founded assessment of the habilitation Candidate's scientific achievements with regard to the requirements referred to in Article 219, section 1, point 2 of the Act, and prepare a review,

- 2) may, as part of the review referred to in point 1 above, additionally assess whether the habilitation Candidate meets the prerequisite referred to in Article 219(1)(3) of the Act,
 - 3) participates in votes and discussions at meetings of the Habilitation Committee, including the Habilitation Colloquium.
4. A member of the Habilitation Committee participates in votes and discussions during the Habilitation Committee meetings, including the Habilitation Colloquium.

§ 9

A meeting of the Habilitation Committee, including the habilitation colloquium, may be held using electronic means of communication. In the situation referred to in the previous sentence, only the Chair of the Habilitation Committee shall sign the resolution and the minutes of that meeting.

Reviews and habilitation colloquium

§ 10

1. Reviewers, within 8 weeks from the date of delivery of the Application to them, submit their reviews to the Secretariat of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences.
2. Upon receipt of the reviews, the Director of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences verifies that the reviews meet the requirements of the Act and the agreement referred to in § 6, paragraph 6, item 2.
3. Successively, after the acceptance of reviews meeting the formal requirements, the Secretariat of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences forwards them immediately to the members of the Habilitation Committee and to the habilitation Candidate.
4. The habilitation colloquium shall, except as provided for in paragraph 5, be conducted by the Habilitation Committee at its meeting.
5. The habilitation colloquium shall not be held if at least 2 reviews are negative.

6. The habilitation colloquium shall be public, with the exception of the colloquium on achievements referred to in Article 219(3) of the Act.
7. The Chairperson of the Habilitation Committee shall, in agreement with the Habilitant, set a date for the habilitation colloquium, taking into account the date referred to in section 8 below, the date referred to in § 11, section 8, and the date in § 19, section 2.
8. The Chair of the Habilitation Committee shall inform the habilitation Candidate and the other members of the Habilitation Committee of the date, time and procedure of the meeting at which the habilitation colloquium will be held at least 14 days before the date set.
9. The Secretariat of the Scientific Board shall immediately announce on the website of the Institute for the History of Science PAN:
 - 1) name of the habilitation Candidate,
 - 2) the scientific achievement indicated in the Application,
 - 3) the information referred to in paragraph 8 above.
10. The habilitation colloquium shall be held in the presence of at least five members of the Habilitation Committee, including the Chairperson and the Secretary.
11. If the habilitation colloquium is conducted using electronic means of communication, the Secretary of the Habilitation Committee shall be obliged to confirm the identity of the habilitant appearing online. With the consent of the Habilitation Candidate, the proceedings of the habilitation colloquium may be recorded on a medium in the form of an audio recording attached to the file and archived.
12. The habilitation colloquium consists of two parts:
 - 1) In the first part, the Habilitant presents his scientific achievements and indicates his contribution to the development of science;
 - 2) in the second part, there is a public discussion on the subject of the habilitation Candidate's scientific achievements, in which:
 - 1) The Habilitation Committee shall discuss with the Candidate the scientific achievements indicated in the Application, and in addition the habilitation Candidate may respond to the reviews presented;

- 2) The habilitation Candidate shall answer any other questions, if any, permitted by the habilitation colloquium instructor.
13. At the end of the habilitation colloquium, the Habilitation Committee shall, without the participation of third parties, hold a deliberation and by secret ballot, with a simple majority, adopt a resolution on the acceptance of the habilitation colloquium.

Resolution containing an opinion on the conferral of the habilitation degree

§ 11

1. At its meeting in open ballot, the Habilitation Committee shall adopt a resolution containing a positive or negative opinion on the conferment of the habilitation degree upon the habilitation Candidate. At the proposal of the Candidate, the Habilitation Committee shall adopt a resolution by secret ballot.
2. The meeting referred to in paragraph 1 shall be held in the presence of at least five members of the Habilitation Committee, including the Chairperson and the Secretary.
3. The Habilitation Committee in particular:
 - 1) shall, on the basis of the reviews submitted, assess whether the habilitation Candidate has in his or her oeuvre the scientific achievements referred to in Article 219(1)(2) of the Act,
 - 2) assesses whether the Candidate demonstrates significant scientific activity as referred to in Article 219(1)(3) of the Act.
4. In the event that at least two reviews of the habilitation Candidate's scientific output have been negative, the Habilitation Committee may not submit a positive opinion on the conferral of the habilitation degree.
5. If the resolution expressing a favourable opinion did not receive the required simple majority of votes, the Habilitation Committee shall be deemed to have adopted a resolution expressing a negative opinion on the conferral of the habilitation degree.
6. If the habilitation Candidate's scientific achievement is considered to be an outstanding contribution to the development of a scientific discipline, the Habilitation Committee

may make a reasoned request to the Scientific Board to confer the degree of Doctor of Science with distinction.

7. The resolution referred to in section 1 shall contain a statement of reasons, in particular by indicating the reasons why the Habilitation Committee has adopted a specific assessment of whether and to what extent the Candidate fulfils the requirements for the conferment of the habilitation degree. The draft statement of reasons shall be prepared by a person designated by the Chairperson of the Habilitation Committee. The contents of the justification referred to in the previous sentence shall be agreed upon by the members of the Habilitation Committee.
8. The Habilitation Committee shall, within six weeks of receiving the review, transmit to the Scientific Board a resolution containing an opinion on the conferral of the habilitation degree on the Candidate, together with the grounds for the opinion and the documentation of the proceedings for the conferral of the habilitation degree.

Resolution on awarding or refusing to award the habilitation degree

§ 12

1. The Scientific Board shall decide whether to confer the habilitation degree or to refuse to do so on the basis of the resolution referred to in § 11 within one month of receiving it. At a meeting of the Scientific Board, the Secretary of the Habilitation Committee shall present the proceedings of the Habilitation Committee, the outcome of the colloquium and a resolution containing a positive or negative opinion on the conferral of the habilitation degree on the habilitation Candidate, together with justification.
2. The Chairperson of the Scientific Board
3. may invite members of the Habilitation Committee who are not members of the Scientific Board to attend the meeting of the Scientific Board referred to in paragraph 1, but without the right to vote.

4. Subject to paragraph 4, a resolution to confer the habilitation degree shall be put to the vote. In the event that it does not receive an absolute majority of votes, the Scientific Board shall put to the vote a resolution refusing to confer the habilitation degree.
5. If the opinion of the Habilitation Committee is negative, the Scientific Board shall adopt a resolution refusing to confer the habilitation degree.
6. The resolution of the Scientific Board to grant or refuse the habilitation degree is an administrative decision.
7. The Scientific Board, on the proposal of the Habilitation Committee, may adopt a resolution to confer the degree of “habilitated doctor” with distinction.

Other activities of the Scientific Board, manner of taking action by the Scientific Board

§ 13

1. In the event that the habilitation Candidate withdraws the Application, the Scientific Board shall put to a vote a resolution to discontinue the proceedings for the conferment of the degree of doktor habilitowany to the Candidate.
2. The resolution referred to in paragraph 1 above, which has received the required majority of votes, is an administrative decision.
3. In the event that the resolution referred to in para. 1 above does not receive the required majority of votes, the habilitation Candidate shall be notified of the negative assessment of his or her application and the procedure for conferring the habilitation degree on the habilitation Candidate shall be continued. The resolution referred to in the previous sentence shall not be subject to appeal.

§ 14

1. At the meeting of the Scientific Board during which the Habilitation Committee is appointed in the proceedings for the conferment of the degree of doktor habilitowany to a habilitation Candidate who is not a researcher at the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences and who has not been fully exempted from the fee referred to in § 5, the Scientific Board shall adopt a resolution, which shall be an

administrative decision, to require an advance payment to cover the fee (costs of the proceedings) for the conduct of the proceedings from the habilitation Candidate or from the entity or entities referred to in Article 182, para. 7 of the Act.

2. Following the adoption of a resolution to confer the degree of doktor habilitowany or to refuse to confer it, or a resolution to discontinue the proceedings for the conferment of the degree of doktor habilitowany, adopted with regard to the Candidate referred to in section 1, the Scientific Board shall adopt a resolution which is an administrative decision concerning the determination of the amount of the fee (the costs of the proceedings) for the conduct of the proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree to the Candidate, the persons obliged to pay for it, as referred to in section 1, and the date and manner of its payment.

§ 15

1. Except as separately provided for in these Regulations, resolutions of the Scientific Board in the course of proceedings for the conferment of the degree of doktor habilitowany shall be adopted by secret ballot, by an absolute majority of votes, in the presence of at least half of the number of persons entitled to vote referred to in paragraph 2.
2. Those entitled to vote on matters reserved to the competence of the Scientific Board, as referred to in these Regulations, are members of the Scientific Board holding the academic title of professor, the academic degree of doktor habilitowany and persons who have acquired powers equivalent to those of doktor habilitowany.

§ 16

1. Resolutions of the Scientific Board which constitute administrative decisions or decisions shall be signed by the Chairperson of the Scientific Board.
2. Subject to the proviso referred to in paragraph 2a, resolutions of the Scientific Board which constitute decisions or administrative rulings shall be drawn up in duplicate. One copy of the resolution referred to in the preceding sentence shall be delivered to the habilitation Candidate.

3. The resolutions referred to in § 14 shall also be delivered to the designated entity or entities in the case where the entity or entities referred to in Article 182, section 7 of the Act are obliged to bear the costs of the proceedings for the conferment of the habilitation degree.
4. The draft justification for the Scientific Board's resolution on the refusal to confer the degree of doktor habilitowany to the Candidate shall be prepared by the Secretary of the Habilitation Committee and submitted to the Chairperson of the Scientific Board. The draft justification accepted by the Chairperson of the Scientific Board constitutes the draft justification for the resolution of the Scientific Board refusing to confer the degree of doktor habilitowany to the Candidate.
5. In matters not regulated, the provisions of the Rules of Procedure of the Scientific Board of the Institute of History of the Polish Academy of Sciences shall apply *mutatis mutandis*.

§ 17

The opinion referred to in Article 193(3) in conjunction with Article 224(1) of the Act shall take the form of a resolution of the Scientific Board, the grounds for which shall be drawn up by the Chairman of the Scientific Board.

Habilitation diploma

§ 18

1. The Secretariat of the Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences shall prepare the habilitation diploma and its copy in accordance with the regulations issued pursuant to Article 181 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, as well as in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.
2. The model of the habilitation diploma in Polish is set out in Annex No. 1 to these Regulations. The Institute for the History of Science of the Polish Academy of Sciences applies a single model of the habilitation diploma, regardless of the type of scientific

achievement forming the basis for the proceedings for the conferment of the degree of doktor habilitowany.

3. At the request of the person awarded the degree of doktor habilitowany, the Institute shall issue a copy of the diploma in English, French, Spanish, German, Russian or Latin. The model of the habilitation diploma in English is set out in Annex No. 2 to these Regulations.

Data published in BIP and POL-on System

§ 19

1. The organisational secretaries of the Scientific Board of the Institute for the History of Science PAN shall post successively, without undue delay, subject to paragraph 2, on the pages of the Public Information Bulletin of the Institute for the History of Science PAN:
 - 1) Conclusion,
 - 2) Composition of the Habilitation Committee,
 - 3) reviews,
 - 4) information on the date, place and manner of the habilitation colloquium
 - 5) a resolution of the Habilitation Committee giving its opinion on the conferral of the degree and its grounds,
 - 6) a resolution of the Scientific Board to confer the degree of doktor habilitowany or to refuse to do so.
2. The information referred to in paragraph 1, point 4 above shall be made available no later than 10 days before the date set for the habilitation colloquium.
3. The Director of the Institute of History of Science PAN, through the Secretariat of the Institute for the History of Science PAN, posts in the POL-on System:
 - 1) the data of the habilitation Candidate referred to in Article 348(1)(2)(a) and (b) of the Act,
 - 2) The application and the date of its submission,
 - 3) data of the members of the Habilitation Committee as defined in Article 348(1)(2)(d) of the Act,
